# RESULTS of the 2020 GENERAL ELECTION



Below is a breakdown of Michigan's results for several national and state offices, including the final vote tallies for two state ballot proposals. *Last updated* 11/14/2020.

#### **President**

**Joe Biden** and **Kamala Harris** were elected as President and Vice-President, respectively, of the United States.




#### **State Board of Education**

**Gary Peters**<sup>(i)</sup> was elected as a U.S. Senator for Michigan. He joins Debbie Stabenow.




# **Proposal 1**
